## OSHA & Infection Control presented by Dr. Howard Shayne (3 CE)

The OSHA Bloodborne Pathogen Standard requires employers who have employees with occupational exposure to blood and other potential infectious material provide training for those employees annually. In addition, for DANB Certified Dental Assistants, two hours of infection control and one hour of OSHA's Bloodborne Pathogens credits are required annually. This course covers both areas of required training. The OSHA standard contains 15 elements that will be addressed in the training. The major exception is that the standard



does not require an annual review of the employer's exposure control plan. This portion of the requirement will need to occur in the participants' individual office setting. However, a discussion of the elements required in all plans will be included. The course will provide 3 hours of CEU (2 hours IF & 1 hour BBP). You will learn how to be aware of safety issues involved in dental care, be able to apply modern infection control principles, be knowledgeable about requirements of the OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Standards and be able to critically analyze different methods for instrument decontamination.
