It is the responsibility of the owner of x-ray machines to provide for both initial and periodic inspection of x-ray machines, and to ensure radiation shielding is adequate, through use of MRCP-approved Qualified Experts (QEs) in radiation safety.

National Provider Identification

The National Provider Identifier (NPI) is a Federally-issued10-digit unique standard identification number that all health care providers must use when submitting electronic claims. Getting an NPI is free — not having one can be costly. A provider's NPPES registry types cannot be modified once it is issued, and it remains with them regardless of their position or where they reside or work. As a dentist, you may have both an individual and group NPI. Find complete information at nppes.cms.hhs.gov.

INFECTION CONTROL & OSHA

Infection Control Requirements

Missouri law requires dentists follow the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and Prevention guidelines on infection control. cdc.gov/oralhealth/infectioncontrol/index.html

Job Safety & Health Protection

OSHA has many requirements concerning infection control, employee safety and training, waste management and hazardous chemicals. You need to obtain a copy of the Bloodborne Pathogen Standard from the ADA or OSHA.

Before You Sign a Contract

When members receive a dental insurance contract, they should read, understand and evaluate it thoroughly to determine if signing the contract is a sound business decision. ADA Members can take advantage of the free Contract Analysis Service, but it must be utilized BEFORE a contract is signed. How does it work? Members send the contract to the MDA first. The MDA will then contact you for additional details if needed, will forward the contract to the ADA and will send the ADA analysis to you once completed. CAS is available at no charge to members who request a review through the MDA. Dentists contacting the ADA direct are charged a \$50 fee.
